£195,102

A redevelopment of a redundant dog kennel block to create a small animal centre for rabbits, rodents, reptiles kittens and others. The new building contains purpose-built units to suit the specific needs of each species.

£31,525

A complete refurbishment of their centre & café, including new floors, ceilings, electrical installation, furniture, tv, lighting and new wall finishes.

£30,000

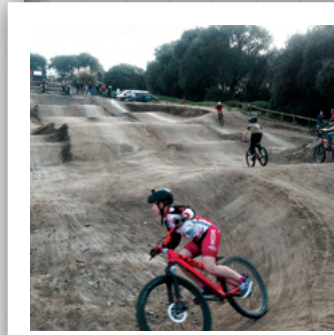
New kitchen, lockers, glazing, carpets replaced and wiring, plumbing & hot water updated. External walls painted with timber repaired & gutters cleaned.

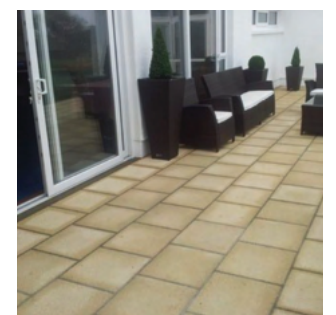

Replaced double, sliding patio doors, repave the patio area. Also pressure washed & redecorated surrounding walls and replace the garden furniture.

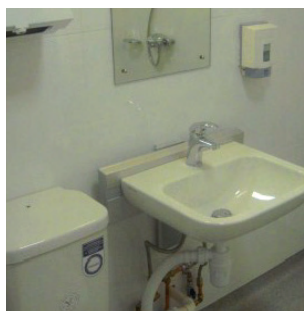

Refurbishment of bathroom into a modern wet room. Including the laying out of a new floor, tiling, adjustable sink and other features to cater for residents with impaired mobility.

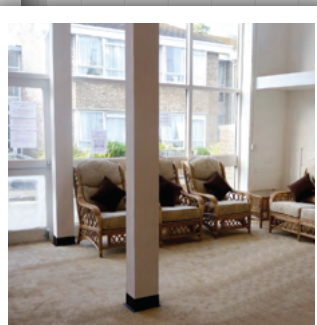

Refurbishment of the charitable café and shop at the entrance of the General Hospital. Giving a new layout, kitchen and dining area.



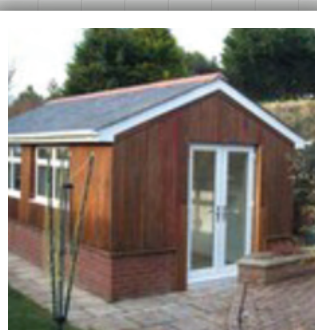
The Multiple Sclerosis Therapy Centre
