The Jersey Safety Council is pleased to advise that the Jersey Safety Awareness Test (JSAT) is now available to employers in the construction and associated sectors.

JSAT is an on-line basic health and safety awareness test available via registered employers and testing stations. Please see the website [www.jsat.je](http://www.jsat.je) for further details.

The scheme provides employers with two options, test your employees at your own business by registering on-line and receive a paper certificate on successful completion of the test, or send your employees to a Registered Testing Station (where a charge will apply) where they will be issued with a rigid plastic card containing the delegates photograph after passing the test.

JSAT can assist employers in complying with the general duties placed on them under Articles 3 and 5 of the Health and Safety at Work (Jersey) Law 1989 and the Health and Safety (Management in Construction) (Jersey) Regulations 2016.

JSAT is not an examination of an individuals' competency, but is intended to raise awareness of health and safety issues in construction.
